

Letter from the Editor.

The first edition of the almanac will include some authors from Germany, Bulgaria, Estonia, Russia and the USA. I will try to briefly introduce few authors and some of their work.

Dr. Eugen Gabovitsch (b. 1938), is a mathematician, scientist, translator, writer, and journalist. He immigrated to Germany from the former Soviet Union in 1980. In 1997 he presented a lecture on N.A. Morosov at the annual meeting for the German magazine "*Zeitensprünge*" ("*Time Jumps*"), which afterwards was published in the magazine. This was followed by several articles on the works of N.A. Morosov, A.T. Fomenko, and G.V. Nosovsky in Germany and English and many papers with his own research results. As a result the little known ideas of N.A. Morosov and A.T. Fomenko began to spread amongst the German historical analytical society. Additionally Dr. Gabovitsch began to popularize the work of his critical German colleagues in Russia. His overview paper about the Western historical analytics *Fomenko is not alone* was placed in one of the books of G. V. Nosovsky and A.T. Fomenko in 2000.

Today the electronic site History and Chronology (www.jesus1053.com) created by Dr. Gabovitsch and evolved by a group of authors, interested in alternative historical ideas, plays an important role in Germany. The website contains German, Russian and English parts and many discussion forums in Russian and German.

After publishing his detailed commentaries to the Russian translation of a book of his German college Uwe Topper (St.-Petersburg, 2003), Dr. Gabovitsch began to work on a Russian book series about the historical analytics. The first book called "*History under Question*" was published 2005 in St.-Petersburg and Moscow. It contains chapters on theoretical history and analysis of its characteristics of the history along with the effect of Western critics of history. The second part of the book is treating chronology from theoretical and historical points of view. His next Russian book "*Prehistory under Question*" will be soon published in Moscow. Presently, Dr. Gabovitsch is working on a new book, "Catastrophism under Question" in Russian. A part of this and his English paper "A chronological revolution made by historical analytics" are published in the Almanac.

Dr. Tabov (b. 1946) is a Bulgarian mathematician, scientist and researcher of historical chronology. He is the author of several works on mathematics, didactics, chronology and history. He is a member of the editing group of advisers for the Almanac of the New Chronology of Fomenko-Nosovsky <http://new.chronologia.org>

He is the founder and the leader of the Seminar, Anachronisms, in Sophia, Bulgaria.

Dr. Tabov wrote a book, "*The Antique Bulgaria*" in Bulgarian. The book can be read at an historical website www.otizvora.com. His famous book, "*When ancient Kiev was christened*" in Russian can be read at the website www.chronologia.org

The almanac contains Dr. Tabov's book "Bulgaria and Trojan War" in Bulgarian, which the author shows that the names of the soldiers in Trojan War were Bulgarian. The ancient Trojan War could have occurred before the V century, when by traditional history the first Bulgarians first appeared in history.

I have taken interview with Dr. Tabov refer to “Seminar Anachronisms” in Russian.

Sergey Morosov (b. 1956) is electronic designer in Tallinn, Estonia. He has his own website <http://sergmoro.narod.ru>.

Morosov is working on proving his hypothesis that the biblical King Solomon is the Russian Tsar Aleksey (1626-76), and the Queen of Sheba is the queen Christina of Sweden (1626-89), the Biblical Temple of Solomon is the Assumption Cathedral of Moscow Kremlin. He believes that several parts of the Bible were written in the XVIII century. The ideas are present in his book “Under the Canopy of the Acacia” in Russian.

The almanac contains his article, “New Chronology and a mystery of A.S. Pushkin’s Talisman” in Russian and “Medieval Chronology and King Solomon” in Russian. The first article presents his hypothesis that the legendary ring of King Solomon is the same that belonged to the Russian poet, Alexander Pushkin (1799-1837). The second article the ancient paintings depicting King Solomon, King David, and the Queen of Sheba were painted no sooner than the later half of the XVII century and during the life King Solomon - Tsar Aleksey, shows that several parts of the Bible ended in the XVIII century.

I have taken interview with Sergey Morosov refer to “Biographer of King Solomon”, in Russian.

The strong advocate of post-catastrophic in Russia is the programmer, **Andrew Pushkarev** (b.1968), who lived in Saint Petersburg, Russia. In short, the main idea of post- catastrophism points is that the global catastrophes described by the American scientist Immanuel Velikovsky (1895-1979) did not occur in the BC XV-VII centuries, but in AD XIII-XIV centuries. This is why history before the global catastrophe can not be restored, but history can be restored after the catastrophes of the XIII-XIV centuries.

His book, “XV Century. Khans and Cataclysms” in Russian which he gathered facts through numismatist, map, and various written evidence he came to the conclusion that two catastrophes of the global scale occurred in the beginning and the middle of the XV century.

The historical genealogist **Maxim Olenev** (b. 1968) in Moscow, Russia is the author of several works on historical genealogy. He has his own website <http://olenev.narod.ru>

Olenev has written “In researches of Rubicon” in Russian where he came to the conclusion that Russian history began since XV century, but Russian and the foreign states communication began since XVI century.

Igor Shumakh (b. 1956) wrote article of series “Calendars of the Hansa” in Russian where hypothesis is developed that the territory of the Hanseatic League has started universal calendar since 1500. Therefore, the territory of the Hanseatic League has started to live since conditional XVI century. Byzantine world era had different equivalent writing as year of the world 6000, 6400, 6500, 6600, 6700, 6800, 6900 and 7000. All of those years combined are equal to AD 1500. It means that all events described by years of the world 6000s, 6400s, 6500s, 6600s, 6700s, 6800s, 6900s and 7000s equal to XVI century. So, when fake history was written all those years were spread through the history.
